Hanshi Moti Horenstein

Hanshi Moti Horenstein was born and educated in Israel. At the age of 5 he began training in the martial arts. During his training he captured several Junior Champion of Israel titles.

In 1983 Hanshi Moti was drafted into the Israeli Army. He served in the airborne Special Forces, and in several commando divisions teaching survival techniques for three consecutive years. In 1986, Hanshi Moti, trained by Dr. Dennis Hannover, captured the title Champion of Israel in the adult heavy weight division - a title that he continued to hold until his arrival to the U.S. in 1989.

With many years' experience teaching both Israeli lay-students and the Israeli Special Forces, Hanshi Moti decided to give back what the martial arts had given him. In 1992, Hanshi Moti Horenstein opened the Survival Center in Spring Valley, New York. This was the first of three locations. Moti Horenstein's Karate & Kickboxing Academy located in New City, New York opened in 1999 and in 2004 Shihan opened his newest school in North Miami Beach/ Aventura, Florida.

Hanshi Moti is sharing his knowledge of the survival technique by teaching special seminars in many martial arts schools, military schools, police departments and security organizations.

Today, Hanshi Moti is an eighth degree Black Belt and continues to compete worldwide as well as being Director and Chief Instructor of the World Survival Hisardut Organization. He holds World Titles in 6 different styles. In 1995, Hanshi Moti was crowned Champion of the World at the International World Oyama Karate Open Championships as well as capturing first place honors in Team USA

Shidokan, representing the United States in Tournaments around the world. Most recently, Hanshi captured Champion of the United States in Muay Thai and in August 1998 he captured Champion of the World at the King's Cup Muay Thai World Championship in Thailand. In September 2004 he became the ISKA United States Heavyweight Champion. In 2008 Hanshi broke the Guinness Book of World Records for most Louisville Slugger baseball bats broken in less than one minute.

Today Hanshi Moti works even harder to bring his students the best techniques through hard work, research and development. This is something that Shihan feels is an important aspect in the Survival Hisardut System.



Master Christopher Rappold

Mr. Christopher Rappold has been studying the martial arts since 1982. He has a bachelors degree in physical education and has earned the title of Master Instructor in the art of Tae Kwon Do. Being a student of the art, Mr. Rappold has had the opportunity to study with some of the finest martial arts practitioners in the world. His intensive study brings the students of Personal Best limitless possibilities in their quest for knowledge.

As a competitor in sport karate, Master Rappold was a three time member of the world champion United States karate team and a member of the Paul Mitchell National Team. Together with these teams he won numerous individual and team national and world titles. In 1995, at the close of ten years of dedicated competition Master Rappold won the W.A.K.O. Pro. Light middle weight world

championship in Providence ,RI. Then in 1997 came back to win the W.A.K.O. Pro World Team Title.

As the Executive Director of Personal Best Karate, Master Rappold is a self-disciplined person who has developed his talents and abilities so as to bring out the best in himself and in his students. As the principle-centered leader of Personal Best, Master Rappold extends his positive influence not only in the schools, located in Norton, Foxboro and South Easton, Massachusetts, but also throughout the community. His efforts on behalf of so many people have been recognized nationally by his representation as an Olympic Torch Bearer as well as on a local level, most recently as the recipient of the "Friend of Children" Award as the Inspirational Role Model.



Ganyao Fairtex

Born Phicheat Arunleung on November 16, 1959 in Thailand he is the Trainer of three Lumpini Stadium champions and ten world champions. He is the trainer for MMA fighters Royce Gracie, Jake Shields, Scott Smith, Gilbert Melendez & James Irvin.
